We are excited to share that we will be replacing the tube system in the drive-up at our Canton Office with an Interactive Teller Machine (ITM). This is an ATM accompanied with a live video feed option, whereas one of our familiar tellers is ready to serve you with your drive-up transaction. Our teller processes your transaction, guiding you through a few steps of the process, and allowing more interaction between you and our teller to answer your questions about accounts, services, and more. With this new technology, the drive-up teller can perform 95% of the transactions that can be done inside the lobby.

PROTECT Yourself from Scams!

With the progression of technology and AI comes more cyber threats! Make sure you really look and think before taking action. There are red flags everywhere, just make sure you know how to spot them.

QR Codes are extremely popular. Unfortunately, scammers link these codes to malicious websites and download spyware onto your device. Make sure you avoid scanning codes without knowing their origin!

While sharing your life on Social Media is fun and exciting, remember that cybercriminal's use that information against you. Don't overshare! Be cautious of accepting requests from profiles with few connections and generic profile information.

Email Phishing is the most common cyber attack. Make sure you pay attention to an emails subject line, the "to" "from" and "Reply" to lines, time and dates, links and attachments, and the urgency to action.

Artificial Intelligence (AI) is an excellent new tool to help create content, video, audio recordings, etc. AI can also be used to impersonate trusted sources. Everything is untrustworthy until proven otherwise.

The most important way to protect yourself is trust your instincts!
